

Proposals for protection zones over submarine cables off Sydney

A brief reminder that the closing date for public comments on the protection zone proposals for the Southern Cross and Australia Japan Cables off Narrabeen and Tamarama/Clovelly beaches is **Friday 10 November 2006**.

ACMA has invited submissions on the proposals and will consider all input before making a decision about whether to declare protection zones over these submarine cables.
