Angling Convention Circuit (ACC) Competition Rules:

1. The ACC rules are to be read in conjunction with the 12-Month Competition rules.
2. The competition runs from July 1st 2011 to June 30th 2012.
3. All of the clubs hosting a convention are required to nominate ANY six (6) angling categories of their choice. These categories will determine the scoring of ACC points. This will be indicated on all convention entries and rule requirements etc.
4. A total of 90 points will be available per convention.
5. Each category will score points in the ratio 5 / 4 / 3 / 2 / 1 for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th places respectively.
6. If there is any tie for a place, the points for those positions will be added and divided and allocated evenly.
7. 3 points will be awarded to each angler attending a convention.
8. Anglers must participate in a minimum of three (3) conventions to be eligible for point score in the final totals at the end of the angling year.
9. The bonus points system used in prior years has been removed. No bonus points will be awarded.
10. The convention circuit list is as follows:
