## Recreational Fishing Community Grants Programme

### Round 4 Successful Projects – New South Wales

ANSA NSW and its prize winning Angel Ring Project have been successful in securing additional funding from the latest round of Recreational Fishing Community Grants. The funding of some \$59,700 will allow ANSA NSW to continue servicing the anglers of NSW who fish the rocks. The project will also enable ANSA NSW to continue educating the anglers of NSW, especially the non-English speaking background anglers who are overrepresented in the drowning statistics.

Congratulations are also extended to two other ANSA NSW Clubs that have been successful in securing grants.

South Sydney Amateur Fishing Association was able to secure some \$59,550 funding for "The **Estuarine Artificial Reefs Project - Botany Bay**". This project will involve the increase in size of the Botany Bay artificial reefs constructed from 'Reef Balls'. These artificial reef locations are open to recreational fishing but closed to commercial harvest.

The Sea Bees Boating Club, as advisors to Hornsby Shire Council were able to secure some \$3,000 funding for The "**Replacement fish cleaning table-Parsley Bay Brooklyn, NSW**". This project will reduce public health risks and improve the visual amenity of the fish cleaning facilities at Parsley Bay, Brooklyn, NSW.
