#### **E-news from the Club Liaisons Officer**

The ANSA NSW electronic database (Email Service to Clubs and their Members) has been brought back up to speed. In order to do this a new database was formulated so as to eliminate returning addresses, old contacts and identify addresses to Clubs.

ANSA NSW has successfully recreated a database that reaches 32 of the 34 affiliated Clubs in the State. Bargo Fishing Club and Northern Rivers Hotel Fishing Club being the only two not on the database yet. Therefore, ANSA NSW can now reach 90% of its Clubs electronically. This guarantees that information can be distributed effectively and efficiently from ANSA NSW to the Clubs. It is then quite important that your club contact on the ANSA NSW database distributes this information to your Club members promptly. Please note that ANSA NSW is and will still mail information out to all its affiliated Clubs after every committee meeting held by the State Committee.

Presently each ANSA NSW affiliated Club in the State that is on the database has at least one (1) contact. Several Clubs have opted to have more than one (1) contact. In fact, we would recommend that each Club have at least two (2) contacts on the database. Listed below you will find a list of Clubs and their contact person/s. If your Club would like to add or change any of the contacts please contact me and I will sort this out with you.

If you are a direct member to ANSA NSW through Sportfishing NSW you too can be put onto the database to receive current and up to date information. So please contact me and we will update the database.

Note that all email contact addresses are kept confidential. The Club Liaison Officer is the only person who can access theses addresses.
