# **Vice President's Report**

Another challenging and busy year for ANSA at both a Branch and National level. Listed below are snapshots of some of the many issues confronting recreational fishing that ANSA has been involved with over the past year. Some have produced positive outcomes - others not so and many are still being dealt with as part of the ongoing negotiation process.

**New ANSA Rule Book.** 2012 was the year for review and update of the ANSA rule book. This is something which ANSA does only every 4 years to coincide with a leap year. A number of important changes were made to the rule book to make it more user friendly and to clear up some areas of possible ambiguity. A new Length Based Species masters Award was introduced to reflect the enormous appeal and popularity this capture and release focussed style of fishing has with ANSA members. New rule books have been printed and are in the process of being circulated to every ANSA member.

**Commonwealth Marine Reserves.** ANSA did lodge formal submissions in respect of the Coral Sea and Temperate East marine reserves and gave its support to the submissions prepared by Recfishwest for the Southwest and Northwest reserves. ANSA in common with all other peak recreational fishing bodies and recreational fishers generally is very concerned by the lack of hard science driving the governments rationale to zone so much of the proposed marine reserves as marine parks where no fishing will be allowed. ANSA is not opposed to the concept of marine reserves but we are opposed to the notion that recreational fishers be locked out of huge areas of our oceans when there is no demonstrable case that recreational fishing has any detrimental impact on marine biodiversity. ANSA together with other peak bodies will continue to have meaningful dialogue with the current government and its advisors in an ongoing endeavour to secure a better deal for recreational fishers and to initiate a multi peak body National anti marine park campaign if warranted.

**NSW Independent Scientific Audit of Marine Parks.** ANSA did lodge formal submissions to the audit panel and also appeared before the panel to present further evidence. It is too early to speculate on what will come out of this scientific audit but it is our hope that a more scientifically based criteria for zoning of the parks will be adopted for the future and that shore based fishing be allowed along all beach and rock faces currently zoned as no fish areas for recreational fishers

**Murray Darling Basin.** ANSA in conjunction with other peak recreational bodies has formally voiced concerns that the issue of recreational fishing was not factored into the political debate on the future management of the MDB. This has been rectified thanks very much to a socio economic study of recreational activity in the MDB commissioned by Fisheries Victoria at the request of VRFISH. There are still a lot of conflicting issues to be sorted out between the various states and the commonwealth in terms of water allocation and how our water reserves are prioritised but hopefully in the final wash up we will end up with a much healthier river system and a better and more productive vital inland fishery.

**Super Trawler.** ANSA has voiced its opposition to the proposal to allow the Dutch registered “Magiris” super trawler to fish in Australian waters for jack mackerel and redbait which are important food stock species for tuna and other pelagic species so important to recreational fishers. Despite claims by government agencies that science exists to ensure that the commercial take of these species will have no detrimental impacts on stock numbers or pelagic predation, this view is not shared by recreational fishing peak bodies and we have genuine concern with the risk of local area depletion if trawling activities are concentrated in one particular area. Rejection of the Magiris licence application now rests with the Australian government and a National anti Magiris campaign has now been launched.

**Grey Nurse Sharks.** ANSA maintains a role on the commonwealth GNS Recovery Plan project and has been pressuring the Commonwealth to publicly release the plan and supporting GNS data that was in final draft form some years ago. ANSA has also been involved with a working group established by the NSW government to review its management plans for GNS and the effectiveness of GNS protection zones. Hopefully there will be some positive progress on these issues soon.

**Cronulla Fisheries Research Centre of Excellence.** ANSA is very concerned by the intention of the NSW state government to close down Cronulla Fisheries and transfer all staff to a host of regional locations as part of its decentralization programme. Quite apart from the potential loss of more than half of the fisheries research and administrative staff currently located at Cronulla who for a variety of reasons will not relocate, there exists no business case by the government to justify the closure of Cronulla and what its intentions are for this valuable piece of waterfront real estate. ANSA has been a strong supporter of Fisheries staff in their opposition to the closure and we are pleased that a Legislative Council Select Committee has been established to review the government’s decision to close Cronulla. ANSA has lodged a formal submission to the Select Committee which at this stage cannot be made public until all submissions are made public.

**Pittwater Recreational Fishing Haven.** ANSA has made submissions to the NSW government for the establishment of a new RFH in Pittwater and for a buyout /reduction of commercial fishing effort in the Broken Bay and Hawkesbury river systems. It is ANSA’s concern that translocation of effort and take by commercial fishers who previously fished Sydney Harbour have placed undue pressure on the Hawkesbury system. ANSA has also made the case for Sydney harbour and its tributaries to also be afforded RFH status to ensure there is no return to commercial fishing should ever the toxic waste problems be remedied.

**Fishing Safety.** ANSA will continue to expand on its very successful and highly profiled Angel Ring and Fishing Safety Education projects. These projects which had their roots in NSW will now be rolled out nationally. This will be a major challenge for all involved with these critically important life saving projects. ANSA is also actively engaged in the debate on the compulsory wearing of life jackets when rock fishing and will endeavour to push the case for a common sense and practical outcome for rock fishers should this become a regulation.

**Reducing Emissions from Non Road Spark Ignition Engines.** ANSA has made submissions to the Dept of Sustainability, Environment, Water, Population and Communications recommending that much tougher emission standards be introduced for the manufacture and importation of marine engines. It was alarming for ANSA to learn that Australia has one of the most lax marine engine emissions standards in the modern world and that almost all engines currently sold within Australia do not meet USA or European emission standards. We have been a dumping ground for obsolete technology. Hopefully we will soon see the introduction of internationally accepted marine engine emission standards.



**Recreational Use of Council Dams.** ANSA together with other local bodies was successful in having Goulburn Council agree to allow the continued use of electric motors on its dams including the very popular Pejar dam. ANSA will continue to push the case for recreational fishing to be allowed on all NSW freshwater dams and for the use of electric powered watercraft.

**Boat Ramps and Fishing Platforms.** ANSA has strongly argued the case for additional and improved boat ramp facilities within the Sydney Metropolitan area and has had some success with modifications to the Botany and Rose bay ramps now underway. ANSA is still pushing the case for more fishing platforms within its major urban waterways and to resist pressure by some councils to restrict recreational fishing at piers and jetties.

**ANSA Public Liability Insurance Scheme.** This scheme is still running very well and provides a very comprehensive level of protective coverage for clubs and members at a competitive price. All clubs are encouraged to join the scheme which when run in conjunction with the defined accident insurance scheme ANSA has with the NSW Government Sporting Insurance Committee, offers our clubs and members one of the best protective packages available.

**Peak Bodies / Committees.** ANSA has maintained its presence on NSW ACORF and the Licence Expenditure Committee. These bodies provide an excellent forum for ANSA to get its point across to decision makers in NSW Fisheries on important issues such as bag and size limits and changes to regulations that may impact positively and negatively upon recreational fishing. ANSA remains a full member of Recfish Australia and is one of the foundation supporters of the Australian Recreational Fishing Foundation (ARFF) which is a new national peak body combining the membership of most established national peak recreational fishing bodies and industry players such as the Australian Fishing Trade Association (AFTA). This new body which will be based in Canberra will forge the future basis for collective advocacy on all national issues that have a relevance to recreational fishing. ANSA is in the process of becoming a full member of ARFF.

**Thank You.** ANSA could not undertake all of these functions if it were not for the small team of dedicated volunteers at a Branch and National level who give up so much of their own time to get personally involved in these issues. Thank you one and all. There are always openings and opportunities for new faces on the Branch and National committees so take the chance and get involved. It is a rewarding commitment.

Together with the ANSA NSW Committee the ANSA NSW secretary has conquered another challenging and eventful year. As a committee we have done our best to answer all the questions and defend our rights as anglers.

The committee has been proactive in ensuring important information concerning changes to fishing in the State of NSW, rule changes, competition updates and record updates got to our membership in a prompt and timely fashion. Our membership can be assured that ANSA has been well represented at both a State and Federal level.

## **Promotional Material**

There were several promotions during the past year, the biggest being the Columbia Sportswear promotion. Clubs took the offer up readily and hundreds of shirts were purchased, embroidered and dispatched. The recent negotiations with Columbia Sportswear have ensured that ANSA NSW members can still purchase a value for money shirt for the coming year. A recent updated flyer and order form was circulated to ANSA NSW Clubs electronically and already several clubs have once again taken up the offer.

## **Tightlines Bulletins**

The Tightlines bulletin is still in circulation, with several bulletins distributed throughout the year, the latest one being June 2012. We expect the next bulletin to be issued not long after this year's delegates meeting, annual general meeting and the presentation night.

## **Committee Meetings**

The Committee meets quarterly during the fishing calendar year with its most recent meeting being July 2012. Don't forget clubs are more than welcome to attend committee meetings as they see fit. It probably would not be a bad idea to come and see how things are run at a State level. It can be very rewarding and many hands make light work. We are always looking for new enthusiastic club members to join the committee and help run ANSA NSW.

## **The Email Database**

The ANSA NSW email database currently hosts all ANSA NSW affiliated Clubs. Most of the Clubs on the database have minimum one contact. In total, the database hosts more than 100 points of contact, which includes Sportfishing NSW members. As in previous years, the electronic mailing system has really helped ANSA NSW operate more efficiently, economically and has aided their capability for distributing up to date information quickly. Hundreds, if not thousands of emails are distributed to all our member clubs each year. If you are not receiving electronic information from ANSA NSW please let me know and I will most definitely add you as a contact to the database.

Concerns are still with the clubs channelling information onto their own members from ANSA NSW, but there is more and more evidence that it is happening. Some of the larger Clubs are passing on the information ANSA NSW sends out as they see necessary, but there are concerns with many of the other affiliated smaller clubs, especially those that do not put out a newsletter. Hence, what we would like to suggest, especially for the smaller clubs is that you give ANSA NSW as many email contacts as possible for your club members. Do not forget, ANSA NSW has an email protocol and your addresses will be used for distribution of ANSA NSW information only.

The Website.

The ANSA NSW website is the central information hub for all ANSA NSW members. It is a vital tool for distributing information, so make sure you visit at least once a month for any new updates. Not all information is distributed direct via email.

The ANSA NSW website has been maintained regularly through the past 2011/2012 year and is currently up to date. Anything you would need to know about how ANSA NSW operates, how to start a club, how to join ANSA, competition updates, and record updates etc is on our website. We even have a photo gallery with some great photos of fish our members catch.

Another enjoyable year and hopefully if elected, I will be once again able to service our membership efficiently and effectively.

## **Treasurer's Report**

Presented on the following pages are the financial statements for the 2011-12 year and estimated budget for 2012-13. Once again we finished with a small cash deficit for the year of \$440.91, primarily due to unbudgeted expense for sending a representative to the National Recreational Fishing Conference (reflected in Travel/Meeting expenses). Other expenditures remain fairly consistent with past years. Membership revenue was down a bit on budget, but so were total expenses, as the Committee continues to find savings where possible.

During the year, ANSA were offered the opportunity to purchase a purpose-built fishing trailer, which we did to provide Tony Steiner with an asset to use with his Fishing 4 Therapy project. We also prepaid next year's Sporting Injury Insurance premium. As such, our bank balance is down compared to last year, to \$15,910.71; however the money for the trailer will be repaid to the ANSA account once additional project funding is secured.

2011-12 was a busy year for the Angel Rings project, with the bulk of the \$40,000 received in 2010-11 being expended on project activities. A further \$21,000 was received from the NSW License Trust in 2011-12, with around \$4,000 left at the end of the year. Stan has covered the Angel Rings project in more details in his report.

The Fishing 4 Therapy grant received in 2010-11 was also fully expended during the year. Further disabled fishing workshops were held with more great stories to tell. Funding to continue this great initiative is currently being sought. See the project report elsewhere for details.

- Remove and combine divisions in the 12 month competition (poorly contested)
- Make the 12 month competition and state record forms simpler
- Update the 12 month competition and state record databases (thanks to Shane Jasprizza for completing this)
- Moving the responsibility for ensuring the correct completion of the 12 month competition and state record entries, to the club recorders
- Complete regular updates to the 12 month competition
- Complete two updates in the month of June for the 12 month competition
- Finalizing the 12 month competition results as soon as possible at the end of the year
- Changing the points scoring for the ACC so it's based on 'Participation' not 'Angling prowess'

Not all of the changes were well received by Clubs and Anglers (remember there are 1175 members and 33 clubs). On the whole I believe the best outcome has been achieved.

I do ask that you take a serious look at the composition of the NSW and National committee; you will see the same names coming up time and again, also year after year.

The sad part is that the same several people give tirelessly to our organization as well as other 'Fishing related' organizations.

It's time for others to step up and become a part of the committee, failure to do this will see the rest of the committee continue to work tirelessly, and then resign and leave. With the technology age upon us and the way things are going, organizations and clubs are in a serious situation of disappearing. It's up to you to make ANSA NSW and ANSA National survive.

Finally, thanks for participating in the 12 month competition and putting in state record claims. It has been great to meet so many of you in person at the conventions.

# **Angel Ring Coordinator's Report**

It seems I always open my reports with the following line;

"The very first thing that needs to be said is a very big "Thank-You" to all the ANSA NSW members and clubs who put their hands up each and every year to chip in and help us out in maintaining the Angel Ring Project"

So once again, why change a thing as it still rings true.

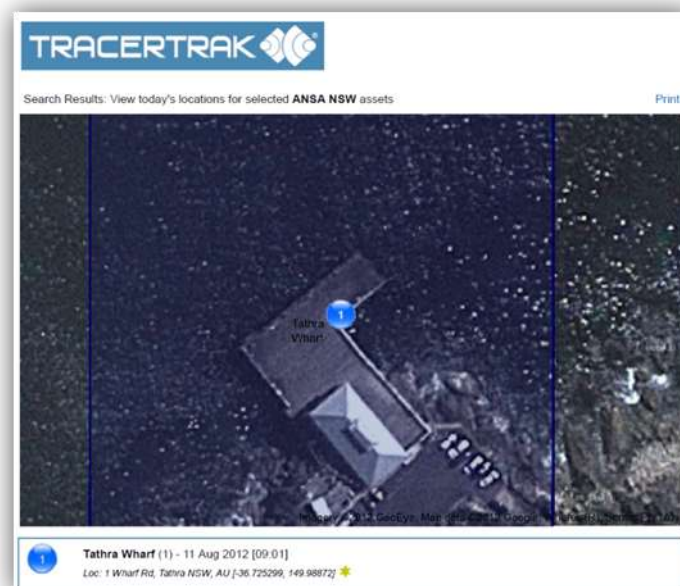
In the 2011 / 2012 fishing year we responded to 30 call outs that involved mainly lost or missing rings but also the need to replace a few posts and for those not familiar with the task involved, just checking and maintaining the 116 assemblies is a huge job. Some of these are a few minutes from a sealed road, some are hours away so a huge effort is needed year in and year out to make all this happen.

In the 2011/2012 season we clocked up 3 confirmed rescues.

The first 2 rescues in December of 2011 were anglers who had been swept off the rocks whilst rockfishing. The 3<sup>rd</sup> one was in February of 2012 and involved an ocean kayaker who had his craft smashed on the rocks of a break wall in big seas and used the ring to eventually swim to the beach where paramedics were waiting for him.

Whilst we have had no new rings installed this year, in February of this year we submitted 15 new applications for locations between Evans Head and Byron Bay. Whilst all the locations within National Parks have been approved, the process has been stalled whilst we wait for approval for locations on break walls. This is also of concern to us as we have 2 other locations on the break walls at Lake Illawarra that have been in limbo for months. We are trying to work through the problems with Crown Lands.

During 2011 / 2012 we also tweaked and continued to trial the asset trackers in selected angel rings. Pivotel, a QLD based asset tracking and Software Company sent one of their technicians down to update the trackers embedded within the angel rings and then the rings were redeployed in the field.






This allows us to keep an eye on them from anywhere in Australia and the World from any smart phone or computers connected to the www. ANSA NSW has plans to further deploy another 30 – 40 trackers in 2012 / 2013.

So once again, a big effort from all and we are always thankful of the support given to us by the NSW Trust that enables us to keep the project ticking over.

## Stolen Merimbula life buoy found in Cooma


By NSW POLICE MEDIA July 25, 2012, 3:53 a.m.

Water Police are warning of the extreme dangers posed by the theft of life-saving equipment from coastal rock platforms after recovering a stolen 'angel ring'.

On Thursday 12 July 2012, a life buoy, known as an 'angel ring' was allegedly stolen from the wharf at Lake Street, Merimbula.

The Australian National Sportsfishers Association reported the alleged theft to police from Marine Area Command.

Following extensive inquiries, police from Monaro Local Area Command executed a search warrant at a property on Hawkins Street, Cooma, about 3pm yesterday (Tuesday 24 July 2012).



Police allegedly located the 'angel ring' in a garage at the location. The item was seized and will be returned to the wharf at Merimbula.

The resident – a 21-year-old man – assisted police with their inquiries.

Marine Area Commander, Acting Superintendent Darren Schott, said the life buoys are important life-saving devices and not toys.

"These 'angel rings' are provided by the Australian National Sportfishing Association, with the support of the Department of Sport and Recreation and NSW Sporting Injuries Insurance, at known rock fishing black spots along the state's coast," A/Superintendent Schott said.

"They have been installed on rock platforms for easy accessibility in case of an emergency.

"It is disappointing that anyone would think that it is acceptable to remove an 'angel ring' for any reason, other than a rescue.

"There are a large number of rock fishing incidents where the deployment of an 'angel ring' might make the difference between a rescue and a recovery."

He urged anyone who may be in possession of an 'angel ring' to return it to where it came from or hand it in to police.



# **SPECIAL PROJECTS**

## **Fishing 4 Therapy**

This year has once again seen the programme grow in strength. We have had many requests from new Associations to join in with their members who they feel would benefit from the sessions we offer. Many of those wanting to join us are sister associations to those already with us and have seen the results that have been achieved.

Our trailer has been fitted with a new therapy tank that resides on top of the draw bar. It holds approx 400 litres of water. The carp are placed in this tank so that our fisho's can interact with them through touch and feel. They are encouraged to try and grab tails or stroke the fish. The carp are very placid and perfect for this work. The sides of the trailer had the old sign writing removed from its previous owner and in the next month or two our new sign writing will go up.

Local hardware Mitre 10 - Kingsford Timber has donated folding tables & chairs, a small gas bbq and gas refill cans. Property Rescue has donated walking frames and a wheel chair while AEP Sheet metals have donated the therapy tank and additional metal frame work to the trailer.

There has been interest from the press over the last 12 months. Fishing World has published a story on their internet magazine. The Southern & Wentworth Courier Newspapers have done a small story but will be returning within the month to do a large feature story. We have also been approached by Women's Day who wants to do a feature in their real life section.

We applied and have been approved for a Government grant of approx \$21k, although we have not yet received these funds.

Mid August will see me presenting F4T at the National Recreational Fishing Conference on the Gold Coast. It will enable those within the Rec Fishing Industry to see what we are doing and maybe pick up some financial sponsorship as well.
