

A National Record Chart and Rule Book

ANSA maintains one of the largest and most comprehensive record charts in the world. Records are updated frequently and cover both line class/ weight and trophy length record achievements. There is no charge for submission and processing of National records. You can view the National record charts on the ANSA National website www.ansa.com.au .

ANSA Rule Books are provided free of cost to all members. The rule book is reviewed every 4 years (coinciding with a leap year) to cater for changes in fishing activity and regulation and to broaden the competition agenda. The rule book can be viewed on the ANSA National website and extra hard copies can be ordered via the National Executive Officer.
